Steve shifted a few months back and they have settled into their new rental on Marshlands Road. They have taken on a foster boy who is 12 years old, he is settling in well. Steve continues with regular involvement at three old folks homes doing devotions. Steve has kept in contact with Kieren from the UK who he shared with on the street and who then gave his life to Christ and is growing in his faith.

Roy is looking after his mum after his dad died in March. His mum has been in hospital recently. Roy is still doing prison ministry at Rolleston which is going well. Roy got punched in the face in the city by a guy we know pretty well, this was unprovoked and Roy managed to get a message out of it which he shared at Tuesday Fellowship at Southwest Baptist church talking about turning the other cheek and forgiveness.



Marty has continued speaking at kids camps during the year, a combined Rally camp in June, CDN kids camp at Woodend in July and Forest Lakes camp in September. Sue and Marty head up to Curious Cove on Sunday to speak at their senior camp, I used to speak at these camps around 25 years ago.

Christmas programme at Temuka school was outside due to asbestos in the rooms we usually use. Roy and Marty did 13 Christmas programmes. Alison Anderson was able to get us back into Winchester school again after a 3 year gap. Marty joined with Al Drye again to do Rakaia, Dorie and Chertsey schools.
